From the Operating Committee

The ILBF successfully continues to fulfil its mission of increasing access to legal information around the world, whilst bringing together individuals from the UK, Africa, Asia, South America and the Caribbean. The last few months have seen a number of shipments sent, to be received by organisations in Nepal, Guyana and Malawi, and we are looking forward to sending texts to Zimbabwe shortly.

We appreciate the continued support from our trustees and our international partners in spreading the message of the ILBF. The Asia Foundation helped facilitate our recent shipment of 67 boxes to Nepal. The shipment was destined for three different recipients within the country: Respro, The Forum for Women, Law and Development and The Central Law Library of Kathmandu. The ILBF has forged relationships with publishers overseas in order to promote the work of the charity and find even more new recipients. Most recently, we have featured in the newsletter of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court.

The ILBF are grateful for the unprecedented number of donations that we have received at our storage facility. It is the continued generosity of chambers, law firms and students that enables the ILBF to continue its important work. Recently, the charity has extended partnerships with universities, for example a considerable donation from University College, London. We hope to build on these relationships in our quest for more student textbooks.

An 'unpacking day' was held at the beginning of October with volunteers from the College of Law, Bloomsbury. This involved opening, sorting and organising the donations into their appropriate legal areas, in order to improve the packing process. We are looking forward to working with more students on upcoming packing days to assemble further shipments.
